Chandler J. Howard

Chandler J. Howard, president and chief executive officer of Liberty Bank, is widely regarded as one of the state's top banking executives. A Connecticut native, his banking career started as a part-time teller when he returned home from service in Vietnam. He built his family, and career, as he continued his education, first at Housatonic Community

College, then the University of Connecticut, and ultimately earned his Master's Degree in Management at Rensselaer at Hartford.

Before joining Liberty Bank, Mr. Howard was president of First City Fund Corporation, responsible for the development of New Haven's new Community Development Bank. Previously, he served as President and CEO of Connecticut Innovations, president of Bank of America-Connecticut, and Chairman and CEO of Fleet Bank-Connecticut.
